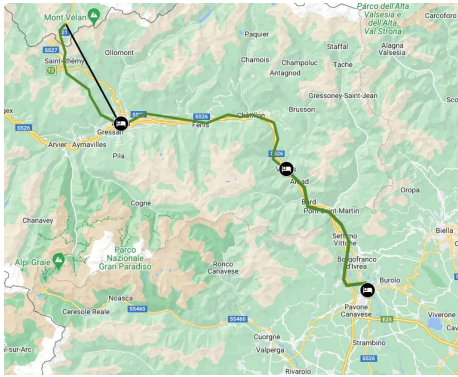


Cycling on Via Francigena From Aosta to Ivrea

Introduction



This **cycling Via Francigena Aosta to Ivrea** section is far **more than a pilgrim trail**: it is an **epic yet easy bike ride** from the **Alps** to the vast and fertile **Po River** plain, perfect for foodies, wine lovers, history buffs and landscape aficionados.

Starting from the Gran San Bernard Pass, on the Swiss-Italian border, this **Via Francigena bike tour** skirts alpine lakes surrounded by 3000m peaks and then freewheels down toward the ancient Roman city of Aosta. Follow cycle paths and quiet country lanes, crossing the fast-flowing Dora Baltea river as you leave the **Aosta Valley**. Continue through a **scenic landscape** of gentle hills and historic sites on this memorable **cycling in Aosta Valley to Ivrea** route, stopping to visit castles, chartreuse monasteries, churches and Roman

ruins while enjoying the best of **Northern Italian cuisine**.

N.B. Saint Bernard Pass open from end of June

Day to Day

Day 1 **Arrive in Aosta**

The journey starts in **Aosta**, a Roman town located in a valley surrounded by mountains. Here you can contemplate the medieval capitals in the silence of the cloisters of **Sant'Orso**, or visit the impressive **Roman theatre**. To end the day, we recommend you take a walk through the alleys of the centre, admiring the high mountain peaks that appear over the roofs of the houses.

Day 2 **Transfer to Saint Bernard Pass and ride to Aosta**

40 km

Today a **private transfer** will take you to the jagged **peaks of the Great Saint Bernard Pass**, where the same Saint Bernard built the **first pilgrim hospice**: from here you will **descend** to Aosta along a **panoramic road** with **breath-taking views**, pedalling first on a State Road and then through orchards and woods, crossing **enchanting** villages such as **Saint Rhemy and Etroubles**.

Challenge: 40km, ascent 104m, descent 1270m

Day 3 **Ride from Aosta to Verres**

50 km

The itinerary continues across the **valley floor**, on the **cycle path** that runs along the **River Dora**, through castles and vineyards. Along the way you encounter the enchanting **Saint Germain castle**, with its imposing **Middy tower** that used to defend the noble **De Mongiovetto family**. From here the itinerary continues to Verrès through breath-taking views.

Challenge: 50km, ascent 230m, descent 450m

Day 4 **Ride from Verres to Ivrea**

35 km

Entering in Piedmont, the **alpine scenery** gives way to the gentle **Piedmont hills**, as ascents and height differences become less and less challenging. You alternate **wood trails to typical towns such as Ivrea**, with its nice old town centre and the **tall tower** of **Santo Stefano**. Continuing the ride you arrive close to the imposing **Serra of Ivrea**, the biggest European drift, until the nice village of **Roppolo** where a cozy, family-run bed and breakfast awaits you.

Challenge: 35km ascent 150m, descent 280m

you can decide to extend with an extra night by doing an optional extra day loop ride around Lake Viverone

Challenge: 40km, ascent 200m, descent 200m

Day 5 **Arrivederci Via Francigena!**

The trip ends after breakfast, unless you have booked extra nights or other optional services with us.

It is possible to continue the cycling on the Via Francigena to Pavia.
