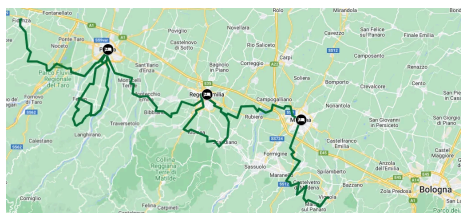


# Food valley cycling tour – Modena to Parma

## Day to Day

### Day 1 **Arrival in Vignola**

### Day 2 **Ride from Vignola to Modena**

**40 km**

This route offers a delightful mix of rolling countryside, cultural stops, and picturesque views, perfect for cyclists of all levels. As you pedal through the lush landscapes, you'll enjoy a blend of natural beauty and cultural heritage before reaching the vibrant city of Modena, where your journey concludes. *Challenge: 40 km, 400 m ascent, 400 m descent*

**Day 3 Ride from Modena to Reggio Emilia****40 km**

Today's ride offers a pleasant landscapes of the Emilia-Romagna region. Starting in Modena ride towards Reggio Emilia, passing through the tranquil Laghi Curiel and the picturesque countryside. This route offers a peaceful escape from city life, with scenic lakeside views, rolling fields, and charming rural landscapes. Ideal for nature lovers, the journey combines the best of Emilia-Romagna's natural and cultural treasures, culminating in the historic city of Reggio Emilia.

*Challenge: 40 km, 50 m ascent, 20 m descent*

**Day 4 Loop ride from Reggio Emilia via Albinea****45 km**

Enjoy a delightful cycle loop from Reggio Emilia through the scenic Albinea countryside, where rolling hills and vineyards create a picturesque backdrop. The ride offers a peaceful escape into nature, with a visit to a local acetia (traditional balsamic vinegar producer) on the way back. Here, you can savor the rich flavors of this regional specialty before continuing your journey, making this loop a perfect blend of cycling, scenery, and culinary culture.

*Challenge: 40 km, 220 m ascent, 220 m descent*

**Day 5 Ride from Reggio Emilia to Parma, or train to Fidenza and ride to Parma****46 km**

Today you have two option you can choose from: An easy cycle from Reggio Emilia to Parma through the tranquil countryside, where quiet roads and scenic landscapes make for a relaxing journey or for a more adventurous option, take a train to Fidenza and cycle along the historic Via Francigena, a route rich in cultural heritage and natural beauty, leading you into the heart of Parma. Whether you choose the serene countryside route or the storied Via Francigena, this ride offers a perfect blend of tranquility and exploration.

*Option A: Challenge: 46 km, 260 m ascent, 270 m descent*

*Option B: Challenge: 45 km, 320 m ascent, 320 m descent*

**Day 6 Parma loop ride via Torrechiara****45 km**

Set out on a scenic cycle loop ride from Parma through the charming countryside via Torrechiara village, where vineyards and rolling hills offer a picturesque ride. This route includes the option for an extended journey over the hills, providing stunning panoramic views and a more challenging ride for those seeking adventure. The ride perfectly balances natural beauty and the peaceful ambiance of the Emilia-Romagna region, making it a rewarding experience for cyclists of all levels.

*Option A: Challenge: 45 km, 250 m ascent, 250 m descent*

*Option B: Challenge: 60 km, 380 m ascent, 380 m descent*
